

Our Programs

Preschool

Our inclusive McWhorter Family Children's Center offers full time care and education to children with special needs alongside their typically developing peers ages six weeks to six years.

Therapy

Pediatric Therapy at First Steps provides outpatient occupational, speech, physical, and feeding therapies to children with special needs in our McWhorter Family Children's Center.

Outreach

The First Steps Community Outreach Program supports families of children with disabilities or delays, age birth to three, in home-based and other community settings.

In 2020-21, First Steps provided

14,764 therapy sessions to 1,019 children

91% of children measured within or above developmental range in literacy skills

96% of children demonstrated improved functioning


The treatment activities provided are relevant to my child's individual needs.


